

## Skill- Distinguishing facts and opinion (區分事實與觀點/区分事实与观点)

A critical reader often needs to know the difference between fact and opinion. It matters a great deal when it comes to reading comprehension.

**Opinions** are not evidence; for opinions to be valid, they must be supported by cold, hard **facts**.

事實/事实 Facts:

- can be proven
- have been proven
- hold true for everybody

觀點/观点 Opinions:

- are somebody's judgment, interpretation, or believe
- can vary from person to person
- are debatable

Opinions may be based on facts, but they are still what we think. Opinions are debatable; facts hold true for everybody.
